Is the cat sad?”



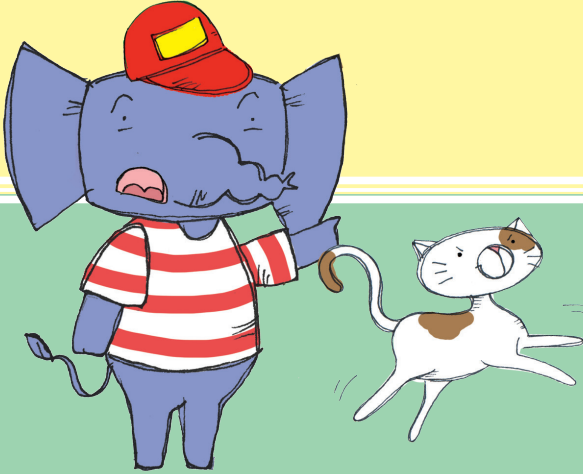
“The cat is not sad, Tippie.
